Brophy Lacrosse Club (BLC) Code of Conduct

All Broncos Lacrosse Club members (players) are required to sign the Broncos Lacrosse Club Code of Conduct as a condition of participation.

As a member of Broncos Lacrosse Club, I understand that I represent Broncos Lacrosse Club and I will do nothing to bring discredit upon the club or myself.

At all times I have a responsibility to:

1. Demonstrate respect to individuals regardless of gender, ethnic or racial origin, sexual orientation, age, marital status, religion, political belief, disability or economic status.
2. Demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship, sports leadership and ethical conduct.
3. Avoid public criticism of athletes, coaches, opponents, officials, organizers volunteers, staff and members.
4. Maintain and enhance the dignity and self-esteem of fellow athletes.
5. Ensure the rules of the sport and spirit of such rules are adhered to.
6. Work as a cooperative member of a team.
7. Protect and promote the health and safety of myself and fellow athletes.

At no time will I:

1. Possess, steal, destroy, vandalize, or in any way endanger the safety or property of others.
2. Possess or use illegal drugs or controlled substances, including tobacco products.
3. Possess or use performance enhancing drugs or inappropriate training methods
4. Possess or use alcoholic beverages.
5. Behave in any way that constitutes harassment, in either a verbal, physical or sexual manner.

When participating as an athlete on a BLC team, I also promise to:

1. Comply with any team rules, including nightly curfews, established by Broncos Lacrosse Club and/or the coaching staff.
2. Attend all team functions, including meetings, practices, meals, games, tournaments and any other function designated by the Board of Directors ("Board") team managers and/or coaches unless specifically excused by one of the above.
3. Travel with the team unless other specific arrangements are made known and approved by the coaching staff.
4. Compete in the games and tournaments chosen by the coaching staff, and attend all related events as directed by the coaching staff.
5. Comply with established uniform requirements.
6. Abide by any additional guidelines established by the Board, team managers or coaching staff to ensure the safety and well-being of team members.

Disciplinary Action:

Minor breaches of discipline will normally be dealt with by the coaching staff, which will discuss the problem with the athlete involved. I understand that failure to comply with the coaching staff's request for discussion of a problem may result in immediate dismissal from the team and, if traveling, return home at my own or parental expense. I further understand that additional sanctions may be imposed after a timely review by the BLC Board, team managers or coaching staff.

I understand that disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to the following:

1. Suspension from or termination of participation in non-competitive team activities.
2. Suspension from or termination of participation in one or more games or tournaments.
3. Dismissal from the team and, if traveling, return home at my own or parental expense.
4. Termination of membership in the BLC.
5. Denial of future membership in the BLC.

I understand that I may appeal any disciplinary action in accordance with the BLC Bylaws.
